


Age Friendly Ambassadors Spotlight Emotional, Mental and Physical Health in Ageing

Age Friendly Ireland's Ambassadors' Day returned on Wednesday 18th June with a clear message: emotional, mental and physical health must take centre stage in how Ireland supports and celebrates ageing.

New insights gathered from Age Friendly Ireland's network of 30 high-profile Ambassadors from the worlds of entertainment, business, sport and public service — including Francis Brennan, Gavin Duffy, Sandy Kelly, Geraldine Plunkett and Celia Holman Lee — reveal that nearly 80% fear cognitive or mental decline more than any other aspect of ageing. When asked what gives them hope, over half pointed to the growing commitment to an inclusive, supportive society that values older people and being able to remain active and independent.

Cycling Without Age (CWA)

Cycling Without Age (CWA) is an Irish charity. It's a nationwide award-winning, volunteer-led, social initiative. Its purpose is to take people unable to walk or cycle for themselves due to illness or disability, for free, slow-cycling spins in their community on specially designed trishaw bicycles piloted by volunteer cyclists.

We move gently, at walking pace, on a comfy bench seat, with seat belts, and warm blankets. Our passengers may be residents in care homes, community hospitals, day-care centres, or those living at home. CWA gives them the opportunity to get out and feel the wind in their hair. We let people know how to obtain these bikes, how to train to be a volunteer pilot, and we promote the concept of enjoying cycling for all ages and abilities.

In recognition of World Elder Abuse Awareness Day, Cathaoirleach of Cavan County Council Cllr John Paul Feeley joined Age Friendly Ambassador Bob Gilbert, Co-chair of Cavan Older People's Council Brian McDermott, fellow elected representatives, Cavan County Council staff and members of Cavan Age Friendly Alliance and Cavan Older People's Council at Courthouse Cavan last week to do help draw attention to this serious issue

June 15th was World Elder Abuse Awareness Day, and this year's campaign focuses on the abuse of older adults in long-term care facilities, with a recent WHO study revealing that nearly 64% of institutional staff admitted to abusive behaviour in the previous year, highlighting the urgent need for systemic change.


